

Youth Volunteer/Service Learning Waiver

Green Seattle Partnership is working with volunteers of all ages to clean up our parks and restore our forests. Volunteering is fun, educational, and a great opportunity for youth to serve their community and enjoy being outside in Seattle's beautiful parks! It is also a great way to earn service hours. Each event is supervised by a trained staff or volunteer lead. Tools and gloves are provided at all events.

Activities may include:

- Removing non-native invasive weeds such as blackberry and ivy
- Moving and spreading mulch
- Planting native trees and shrubs
- Picking up garbage
- Maintaining or building trails

Be prepared:

- Wear long pants, long sleeved shirt and close-toed shoes (boots/old tennis shoes) that you don't mind getting dirty. NO sandals or other open shoe are allowed
- Bring a rain jacket or large plastic garbage bag (w/cut holes for head and arms) in case it rains.
- Water bottle to stay hydrated

Youth Release Form

The following release information is required for volunteer insurance and recognition purposes. For and in consideration of my participation in the Green Seattle Partnership volunteer program, a voluntary, public/private cooperative program (the "Program"), I release, acquit, and forever discharge the City of Seattle, a municipal corporation, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers, and associated non-profit organizations, their officers, agents, employees, and volunteers (collectively, the "Released Parties), from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, action, or liability, on account of, or in any way growing out of, any and all known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen bodily injuries or death, or damage to property resulting from or by reason of my participation in, or transportation to or from, any activity, work, or work site in any way related to the Program. I accept and assume all risks, and assume all responsibility for the losses, costs and/or damages following an injury I (or my child/ward) suffer in the course of my participation in the Program, including disability, paralysis or death, even if caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Released Parties. I understand that the City of Seattle provides medical insurance coverage for bodily injury incurred while I volunteer, and that the medical insurance coverage is secondary to any other insurance I have. I approve of emergency care for myself (or my ward/child) under the direction of the event leader or consulting doctor, if I am unable to approve it myself, including emergency or ambulance transportation and the administration of drugs, tests, anesthesia and blood transfusions to the below-named minor when a physician or dentist at the treating medical facility deems those procedures necessary for emergency treatment. I, as the undersigned, give permission to be photographed and/or filmed and have my image used by the Green Seattle Partnership.
